



SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

June 2006

1. This is a summary of the recommended changes. It may be necessary to thoroughly review the Coaches Advisory Committee minutes to fully understand the proposals.
2. Various groups taking action on these proposals should make a motion to support or deny the proposal as presented by the Coaches Advisory Committee or modify the proposal and vote accordingly.

GYMNASTICS

1. Recommend that the nonjudging meet referee be eliminated at sectional tournaments.

Note: By implementing the use of the modified capitol cup, sufficient time is now available for inquiries and can be handled by the meet referee.

2. Recommend the number of alternates for a team be increased from 1 to 4 for sectionals and state.

BASKETBALL

1. Recommend one additional game be added to the schedule if games are played in Wisconsin. The only exception would be single nonconference games played with bordering states. Otherwise, the 20-game restriction will apply. Teams are limited to one out-of-state exposure provided no more than 3 games are played in conjunction with a tournament/classic. Contests played in these tournaments/classic must be played against state-association member schools. Implementation - 2007-08.
